

Hawkwell made it five wins from five as they stretched seven points clear at the top of the Masters First division. Alan Morriss and Jamie Cole both picked up hat-tricks with the latter not dropping a game in a 5-1 victory. Mandy Holland and Mair Dew picked up the rubber for Fitzwimarc Seconds as they went level on points with Eastwood Seconds in second.

Eastwood Seconds had two matches in the Mixed First division with contrasting fortunes. They lost out in their first, 5-4 at home to B & BP. Emma Clark and Daniel Potter and Tamsin Collinge and Adam Cooper both picked up two rubbers each and Paul and Wendy Hyde got the other for a narrow away win. In the division below, Phoenix Flames Seconds returned to the top with a 6-3 victory over Fitzwimarc Thirds. Terry Maylin and Anne Wallis, Ben Bradford and Vikki Walker and Tracey Carey and Rohan Subasinghe all won a brace each. Adam Peters and Dawn Terry won a hat-trick for Fitz who remain in third.

There were two tight matches at the top and bottom of the Men's Premier. Reigning champions Westcliff fell to defeat for the first time against title rivals Eastwood. Six of the nine rubbers went to three games as Matt Allum and Adam Sibley won all three rubbers for Eastwood. They were supported by a brace from Daniel Hooper and Luke Hill for a 5-4 win. Toby Moon and Rob Perry won two for the home side with Reece Wiggins and Bryn Gillard and James Allpress and Matthew Tonge picking up one each.

Meanwhile, Fitzwimarc picked up their first win of the season against East Thurrock. Ryan Pinnock and Paul Chaplin and Kesh Naidoo and Oliver Escott both won braces for Fitz with Daniel Wigthman and Spencer Collins grabbing the other to win 5-4. Phil Tuffee and Michael Clark won all three rubbers for the visitors and Zak Pryor and Alex Penny picked up one rubber as East Thurrock remain winless at the bottom.

In the Ladies Premier, Leighway stretched eight points clear with a 5-1 triumph against Eastwood. Susan Crompton and Mia Petchey both won three rubbers each for the away side. Kirsty Binstead and Charlotte Mortlock helped Eastwood to their point as three of the six rubbers went to three games.

Finally, Westcliff Seconds beat Hawkwell 4-2 in the Ladies Second division. Barbara Childs won a perfect three rubbers with Hazel Keeble and Christina Scott getting the other to secure the win. Farnaz Siddiq got the two points for the Hawks.
